A heavy mist of crude oil (approx. 3 bbls) was lost to the environment. The mist carried off of the southwest corner of location and impacted an area of approximately 40' X 30'.

2. The impacted area on and off of the location was treated with Micro Blaze (bioremediation agent) and disc/tilled in palce.
