Comments on Inspection:

Tank battery south of well (no sign on tank battery) has two sets of bermed tanks. The northeastern battery is unlined and has heavy hydrocarbon contamination inside bermed area.

Remediaiton is required. Contact NMOCD District 2 Environmental Compliance Officer with site ranking and remediation work plan.

Notify NMOCD District 2 Office 48 hours prior to any remediation work or prior to taking samples where results of the samples may be submitted to OCD.

NOTE: The Nearest wells to this tank battery are operated by Marbob Energy and Melrose Operating. Letter sent to Marbob (nearest well) prompted reply that the tank battery is not owned or operated by Marbob. This notice of violation is being sent to Melrose Operating as the next nearest well to the unidentified tank battery.

In the event that a satisfactory response is not received to this letter of direction by the "Corrective Action Due By:" date shown above, further enforcement will occur. Such enforcement may include this office applying to the Division for an order summoning you to a hearing before a Divison Examiner in Santa Fe to show cause why you should not be ordered to permanently plug and abandon this well. Such a hearing may result in imposition of CIVIL PENALTIES for your violation of OCD rules.
