Wellhead area contaminated. Flowline leak at manifold east of wellhead. Second flowline leak north east of this well, approximately 40 yards along road, has leaked and impacted pasture. Flowline connection at this leak has been dug out and repaired. Third flowline leak has impacted pasture approximately 60 yards further north along road. This leak has been repaired.

Remediation is required. Contact NMOCD District 2 Environmental Compliance Officer with site ranking and remediation work plan.

Tank battery north of this well is heavily contaminated. Heavily saturated soils and poolled oil

inside tank berm and around pump, saturated soils along western fence line and along

separator/tank pad on north side of location. Tank #1 has pooled fluids around valve on west side

of tank. Tank #3 has overflowed and run down tank on south side of tank.

Remediaiton is required. Submit C-141 and contact NMOCD District 2 Environmental

Compliance Officer with site ranking and remediation work plan.
