Oil contained inside firewalls and recovered 15 barrels. The spill area was excavated approximately 0.5' to 1.0' below surface. Soil samples were collected from the excavated area and showed TPH and BTEX levels below the RRAL. The chloride levels do not appear to be an environmental concern. Assessment and closure report has been submitted to the NMOCD for review.
