The NMOCD District 2 (OCD) office is in receipt of a C-141 reporting a release of oil at the above referenced well site on or about 9/8/2005. The source of release is listed as a Tank. The C-141 lists a proposal to line the berm/tank area and install a new tank.

The proposal is accepted with the following stipulations:

1. Provide OCD site ranking for this well site. (Depth to groundwater, Distance to water source if within 1000 ft, Distance to Surface Water Body if within 1000 ft.)
2. Delineation of contaminants (Vertical, Horizontal and type).
3. Planned date for commencement of operations.
4. Notify OCD 24 hours prior to commencement of remediation operations.
