

Replaced the Victualic Clamp with a new one. Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Initially 25bbls of produced water were released due to a hole that developed on the bottom of the Victualic clamp caused by corrosion. We were able to recover 20bbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. The entire release was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluid has been recovered. Contaminated gravel has been removed and we have replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. This location has been returned to its prior condition.
