The water pump failed, causing the water tank to over flow.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*  
Initially 105bbls of oil and 30bbls of produced water were released and we were able to recover 4bbls of oil and 29bbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. The release was completely contained inside the lined facility. All free fluid has been recovered and contaminated gravel has been removed. Fresh gravel has been added to the facility as needed. This facility has been returned to its prior condition.
