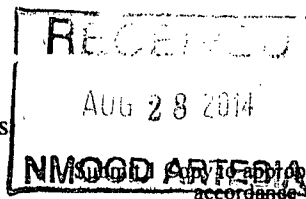

The needle valve atop the pumping-T sheared off releasing water onto the ground. Repairs were made to wellhead and a vacuum truck was dispatched to pick up any standing fluid.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

The impacted area is 300' x 200' to the north of the wellhead. Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
