Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* A hole was discovered in the bottom of the south oil production tank. The tank was taken out of service the day of discovery. The tank was cleaned, repaired, and coated on 1/6/12.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The crude oil was contained inside the earthen containment. A vacuum truck recovered approximately 5 bbls of crude oil. The release affected an area measuring approximately 2,430 ft². During the site assessment, it was noted that there were areas inside the containment that were obviously impacted from previous releases of crude oil and produced water. Following initial response activities, the releases were remediated as per NMOCD recommended guidelines. Please reference the attached *Remediation Summary & Risk-Based Site Closure Request* for remediation details.
