Upon discovery, main load line was shut in order to stop the release. Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\* Affected area- Pad surface in between pumping unit and secondary containment. JWS vacuum trucks were used to recover 60 bbls of oil off pad surface. All contaminated soil will be removed and disposed at an approved NMOCD disposal site.
