water line next to it. There was impact to the nearby pasture. The lines were isolated to stop gas and water.

An area approximately 30' x 50' was impacted in the pasture near the flowline. Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible		
contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
