This release was caused by a butterfly valve on storage frac tank. Vacuum trucks were dispatched to recover the standing fluid.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The spill area remained on the pad area. The pad was scrapped after the standing fluid was removed. Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
