The PLU 315H flowline failed, an area night pumper discovered the release. Bopco EHS was notified Friday morning and was able to respond and collect information. It was discovered that 52 barrels of produced water and 10 barrels of oil was released to the ground surface. No fluid was recovered, the majority of the release remained within the caliche lease road.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The majority of the release remained within the caliche lease road, no fluid was recoverable at the time of discovery.
