This is a request for a time extension on the Four Point Back Pressure Test due August 22, 1979 on the subject well. Due to an excessively high water influx from the Atoka zone, the subject well will be repaired to shut off the water and return the well to production. The well was connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company's pipeline on June 22, 1979 at a rate of approximately 8200 MCF and 30 barrels water. Water production increased and well ceased to flow and was shut-in July 6, 1979. As soon as well is returned to production, we will run Four Point test and forward to you.
