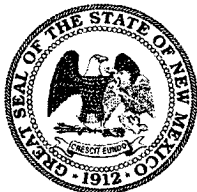
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken. *

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division District II office (OCD) is in receipt of an Initial Report C-141 and Remediation Work Plan for cleanup/remediation of produced fluids releases that have occurred at the above referenced well sites. The Work Plans are accepted as presented with the following stipulations:

1. Notify the OCD District II office 24 hours prior to commencement of activities.
2. Notify the OCD District II office 24 hours prior to obtaining samples where analysis of samples obtained are to be submitted to the OCD.
3. Submit a Final Report C-141 to the OCD District II office upon satisfactory completion of each project.
4. Remediation work on all sites is to be completed by February 15, 2006.
5. Like approval by the Bureau of Land Management.
