25BBLS of oil was released. The release originated on the manway gasket on the horizontal separator due to wear and tear. The valve was shut off to prevent further release and isolate the leak. A new gasket was installed.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

25BBLS of oil was released from the horizontal separator. The release flowed in a northeastern direction. The fluid sprayed vegetation on the northeast side of pad. 15BBLS of oil was recovered via vacuum truck. The approximate size of the total affected area including vegetation spray was 100ft by 100ft on the Northeast of location. An environmental company will be contacted for remediation.
