Well was plugged and abandoned as follows:

1. Pulled 68 joints 2 3/8" tubing.
2. Set 9 5/8" CIBP @ 2150' with 35' of cement on top.
3. Circulate hole with 9.9 ppg brine mixed with 12.5# sk of salt gel
4. Pull 50 joints tubing (End of tubing at 538' KB)
5. Set cement plug from 538' to 425' with 40 sx Class C cement at 14.8 ppg, yield 1.32
6. Set 60' cement plug at surface with 20 sx cement.
7. Dug out around wellhead and cut off conductor. Installed and welded in place dry hole marker.

Work was done by Schlumberger and witnessed by Mr. Gene Hunt w/ BLM Carlsbad.

Approved as to plugging of the well bore.

surface restoration is completed.
