On May 17, 2019, a release occurred caused by a hole in the flowline. The fluids migrated on the lease road and along the edge of the lease road in the pasture. A vacuum truck was dispatched to remove all freestanding fluids. The spill footprint area is shown the KMZ file for your review.

COG propose to excavate the impacted areas in the pasture area at risk. The remediation will be performed in accordance to the NMOCD spill guidelines. Once completed, a report will be submitted for your review.

Authorization is approving the site for delineation both horizontal and verticle. Remediation is dependent on analyticals, etc.
