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
(Note: This method of allocation shall be valid only if the interest ownership between the two pools on this lease remains common. Additionally, if any commingled well on this lease becomes capable of producing at top allowable for the pool in which it is completed, the well shall be separately metered prior to commingling.

Commingled production shall be stored at a central tank battery located within the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 36, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division rules and regulations. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia District Office of the Division upon implementation of commingling operations.
