The above-named company is hereby authorized to surface commingle gas production from the Mosley Canyon-Atoka (Gas - 97493), Mosley Canyon-Strawn (Gas - 81470) and Baldridge Canyon-Morrow (Gas – 71420) Pools originating from the following-described area that encompasses all or parts of State of New Mexico Leases No. VO-5019, L-4501 and VB-0672

Within this area, Mewbourne Oil Company currently operates the Baldridge Canyon "6" State Com Well No. 1 (API No. 30-015-31524) located in Unit P of Section 6, which is currently downhole commingled in the Mosley Canyon-Strawn and Baldridge Canyon-Morrow Gas Pools, the Baldridge Canyon "7" State Com Well No. 1 (API No. 30-015-31339) located in Unit A of Section 7, which currently produces from the Mosley Canyon-Strawn Pool, and the Mosley Canyon "4" State Com Well No. 1 (API No. 30-015-34160) located in Lot 4 of Section 4, which currently produces from the Mosley Canyon-Atoka Pool.

Due to the diversity of ownership between the wells, gas production shall be separately metered by allocation meters prior to commingling. After being measured, the gas will be combined and sent on to a gas sales meter located in Section 6, Township 24 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, on the Baldridge Canyon State Lease. No liquids shall be commingled.

It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority. The operator shall notify the Artesia District Office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.
