

#### Corrective Action Work Plan

Clean up of produced water flow line leaks, identified by Mike Bratcher as PR1-PR10. The soil will be removed to a sufficient depth as to remove chloride contamination. After testing to required action levels, fresh soil will be brought in and re-seeded.

The tank battery will be removed. The berm and any soil contamination within the berm area will be removed. After testing to required action levels, fresh material will be used to rebuild.

Future prevention: Tank battery will be re-buried and plastic lined to prevent any future release. The injection pump and a new 750 bbl gun barrel will be set at the injection well in a plastic lined bermed area. New poly flow line will connect the battery to the injection well.

The wells will be shut in during the clean-up.

Operator,

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division District 2 Office (OCD) is in receipt of a work plan proposal (plan) for remediation of produced fluid releases that have occurred along the flow line to the above referenced well and for remediation of releases that have occurred at the tank battery associated with this well.

The plan is approved as presented with the following stipulations:

- Notify the OCD 24 hours prior to commencement of operations. (The OCD understands that as of date of this letter, some delineation activities have commenced).
- Notify the OCD 24 hours prior to obtaining samples where analyses of samples are to be submitted to the OCD.
- The OCD is to be provided analytical data on all witnessed sampling events within three working days of receipt by operator.
- Remediation requirements and methods may be subject to change as conditions warrant.
- In the event ground water is encountered at any time during the remediation or delineation process, all work is to cease and the OCD notified immediately.
- Submit a Final Report C-141 upon satisfactory completion of project.

As indicated in the Letter of Violation dated July 18, 2006, remedial work is to be completed no later than September 7, 2006. An extension of time may be granted provided good cause is shown by operator.

Please be advised that OCD approval of this work plan proposal does not relieve the operator of liability should their operations have failed to adequately investigate and remediate contamination that pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment. In addition, OCD approval of this work plan proposal does not relieve the operator of responsibility for compliance with any other federal, state, local laws and/or regulations.
