

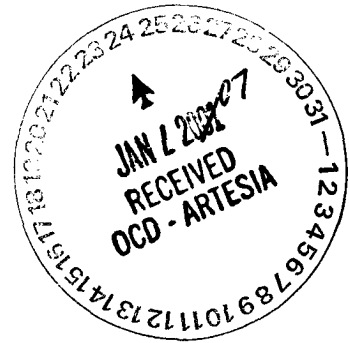

Dear Wesley Ingram:

Enclosed you will find a revised Form 3160-4, Form C-104 and Form C-102. Platform Express Hi-Res Laterolog Array Micro-CFL/HNGS is included with survey which extends to the measured depth of 11,970'; this log was not included initially. Penetration Point has been added to Form 3160-4. A revised C-102 denoting penetration point and actual bottom hole location has been included; the initial C-102 with the APD reflected a vertical location. Our elevation is "ground level".

We cemented the 5 1/2" casing in this well on 9-11 and 9-12-06. We had full returns on the 1st stage then opened the DV Tool at 8000' and circulated cement from the top of the DV Tool. We pumped the 2nd stage with partial returns then no returns for the last 200 bbls. The lost circulation is why we did not lift cement up inside the 8 5/8" casing to 1200'. The Delaware is non-productive. Discussion with our field personnel, no notification was done to the BLM. Discussions with drilling and operations engineers, this was an oversight on our part. Going forward, notification to the BLM will be made on any deviations from our "Conditions of Approval".
