If roads dry somewhat, expect to drill surface hole and run 500 ft of surface casing and cement it on the 28th or the 29th. We will give you further notice once the timing is known.

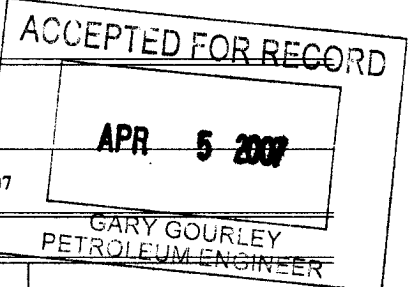
