West Red Lake Unit Well No. 72 (API No. 30-015-28941)
Unit F, Section 8, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, NMPM

Red Lake; Queen Grayburg San Andres Pool (51300)

Perforations: 1,208 feet to 1,960 feet

Eddy County, New Mexico

Reference is made to your request dated September 7, 2007, to increase the surface injection pressure on the above named injection well.

Administrative Order No WFX-719 approved on August 1, 1997, permitted this well for injection into the above referenced waterflood project and perforations and allowed a maximum surface injection pressure of 834 psi. It is our understanding this well will not take water at this pressure and additional pressures are needed to continue this water injection pattern in this area.

The basis for granting this pressure increase is an injection test run by Devon on this well in 2007 and also the maximum pressure limit on offsetting injection Wells No. 50 and 74.

You are hereby authorized to utilize up to 1,000 psi as the maximum surface injection pressure on this well provided the tubing, size, type, and setting depth does not change.

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected fluid is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
