APPLICATION OF TEXAS REEXPLORATION LC FOR PRODUCED WATER DISPOSAL, CHAVES COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 701(B), TEXAS REEXPLORATION LC (OGRID 241908) made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for permission to utilize for produced water disposal its Plains "29" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-005-60875) located 660 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 29, Township 10 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico.

THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:

- (1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations;
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified;
- (3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met; and
- (4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The applicant is hereby authorized to utilize for produced water disposal its Plains "29" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-005-60875) located 660 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 29, Township 10 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico, in such manner as to permit the injection of produced water for disposal purposes into the San Andres formation through an open hole interval from 2210 feet to 2266 feet and through

The operator shall submit monthly reports of the disposal operations on Division Form C-115, in accordance with Rule Nos. 706 and 1120 of the Division Rules and Regulations.

The injection authority granted herein shall terminate one year after the effective date of this order if the operator has not commenced injection operations into the subject well, provided however, the Division, upon written request by the operator received by the Division prior to the termination date, may grant an extension thereof for good cause shown.
