Attached are photographs of the Brainard area taken on 10-3-07

Additional photographs are inset or overlaid on these photographs showing the original reclamation area on 5-17-03.

The area was ripped and seeded in May of 2003 and in a large part has grown back significantly.

Examination of the area shows some lack of growth in an area around the P&A marker roughly 50' x 50'.

It is Beach's opinion that this area would eventually fully vegetate with no additional work. There is some surface chloride crust in this area but the same crust exists in areas that have grown significantly. The reason for lack of growth in this area seems to be a water retention or runoff problem. A subtle crest or mound has formed around the P&A marker that probably promotes water runoff. Vegetation in the immediate area is taking hold, even with a chloride crust, in the minor runoff channels bordering this slight mound.

Beach's plan to accelerate growth in this mounded area around the P&A marker is to rip the mound in a northwest to southeast direction with a backhoe and re-seed. This should create water retention channels perpendicular to the natural flow of water and maybe allow new seed to take hold.
