1/14/08 Acidize Bone Spring 8112'-8128' with 1000g 7-1/2% IC acid. Acidize Bone Spring 7848'-7876' with 1000g 7-1/2% acid.

1/16/08 Frac Bone Spring 7848'-8128' with 39,000g Silverstim and 79,840# 20/40 Expedite.

1/18/08 Clean out sand down to composite bridge plug at 8400' and drill out plug. Circulated hole clean. EOT 2-7/8" at 7675'.

1/24/08 Well is back on production for Recompletion - Bone Spring
