The Initial Report C-141 is approved with the following conditions:

- Due to the site ranking of 10, in addition to the planned analytical for chlorides, soil analyses for BTEX and TPH will be required.
- Please notify OCD 48 hours prior to obtaining samples where analyses are to be presented to OCD.
- As warranted per soil analyticals, within 30 days, on or before August 11, 2008 completion of a remediation work plan should be finalized and submitted to the Division summarizing all actions taken and/or to be taken to mitigate environmental damage related to the leak, spill, or release for approval. The plan must include general site characteristics, site ranking score, soil remediation action levels, soil remediation method, and planned analytical testing for TPH, BTEX, Chlorides or any constituent of concern as applicable.
