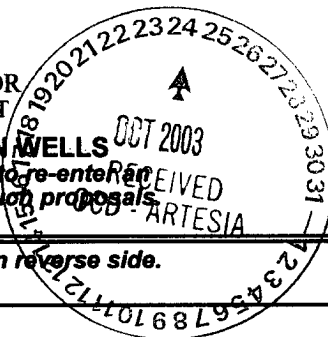

The production from this well currently goes through a stack pack and dehydrater and is measured before entering the Indian Basin Gas Plant gathering system to be sent directly to the plant. Marathon proposes to send this gas production, after measurement, to the Loop Gas Gathering System for transport to the compressors. The updated facility diagram is attached and should replace Exhibit #32 in the original commingle agreement.
