Mr. Allensworth stated that moving the drainage to the east side of the county road would not be a problem and could be done by the County once an APD was approved and Operator was beginning construction of the location.

1. Directions to Location: From the intersection of U.S. Hwy. #285 and County Road #40 (Stargrass Road), go west on County Road #40 approximately 8.0 miles. Turn right at "Y" and go northwest approximately 0.3 miles to a proposed new access road. Follow the new access road survey approximately 100 feet west to this location.

2. New Access Road Description: The new access road begins at the point set forth above (Also See Attached Maps) and will be approximately 100 feet long and 20 feet wide, with no turnouts, cattle guards, culvers, bridges or low water crossings.

3. Anticipated Production Facilities:
