

Yates Petroleum Corporation ("Yates") is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil production from the following two (2) diversely owned wells which are producing from the Coyote-Wolfcamp Gas Pool (97361) and are located on Federal leases in Chaves County, New Mexico:

Football BCF Federal Well No. 2H (API 30-015-34553) SHL Unit I, Sec 1, T12S, R26E, NMPM BHL Unit L, Sec 1, T12S, R26E, NMPM Federal Lease No. NM-106904 320 acre S/2 dedication: Coyote-Wolfcamp Gas Pool

Grid Iron BLI Federal Well:No. 1H (API 30-005-64033) SHL Unit I, Sec 1, T12S, R26E, NMPM BHL Unit I, Sec 6, T12S, R27E, NMPM Federal Lease No. NM-101579 320 acre S/2 dedication: Coyote-Wolfcamp Gas Pool

Each of these diversely owned wells shall be equipped with continuous metering separators for oil production prior to oil being commingled for sales.

Gas production commingling from these two wells is not allowed.

The oil sales point for this commingled production shall be located at the battery near the Football BCF Federal Well No. 2H in Unit I, Sec 1, T12S, R26E. Oil from the Grid Iron BLI Federal Well No. 1H is approved for off lease measurement and sales after being metered on-lease.

It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority. The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.

This order is approved as of the date shown above.
