5/11/09 Spudded well at 9:45 AM. Set and cemented 60' of 20" conductor.

5/14/09 Resumed drilling at 2:00 AM. Notified Darrell Carter with BLM of operations on 5/13/09. Continued to drill, dry drill to TD of 645'. TD 14-3/4" hole to 645'. Could not get casing past 392'. Pulled up to 372' where casing became stuck. Work stuck pipe. RU and attempted to wash around casing with 1". Could not get 1" down far enough to do any good. While waiting on equipment, RU pump down and seat top rubber plug on float collar to keep casing full of fluid as per back off requirement. RU and run freepoint - tool failure.

5/16/09 RU freepoint, top shoe joint at 303', free at 200', stuck at 227'. TIH to 184' and made back off shot. Casing backed off at 50'. Lay down 2 joints casing. RIH with fishing assembly #1. Work into and catch fish. Set off jars. Cannot reset jars.  
(inside new casing tool slick for grapple to set in going down). Re-arrange fishing assembly. TIH with fishing assembly #2. Work into fish. Jar on fish with no appreciable results.



- 5/18/09 Jarring on fish with no movement. Stopped jarring operations and wait on orders. Laid down fishing tools. Cut and slip drilling line. Picked up mill tooth bit, TIH and tagged plug at 312'. Drilled cement and float equipment. Washed to bottom from 312'-645'. TOOH with everything except drill pipe. TIH open-ended to 625'. Set cement plug #1 with 75 sx Class "C" with 2% CaCl<sub>2</sub> (CaCl<sub>2</sub> added with BLM representative, OK). WOC 4 hrs prior to tagging plug. Tagged plug after report time at 540'.
- 5/19/09 Tagged cement at 542'. Set cement plug #2 with 100 sx Class "C" Neat with 2% S1. WOC. Tagged at 295'. Set cement plug #3 with 200 sx Class "C" Neat with 2% S1. Circulated 12 sx. Cleaned pits and rig. Rig Released at 5:15 PM. **WELL IS PLUGGED AND ABANDONED**. Skid rig to the Juniper BIP Federal #6Y
