The APD required setting the 8-5/8" 32# J55 LTC casing at 3300'. Our PDC bit quit drilling at 3231'. EOG obtained verbal permission from BLM field rep (Bob Hopkinson) to set the casing at 3231'. Offset data indicates that the salt section will be adequately covered and the casing seat will be in competent rock. The casing seat should be approximately 30' below the top of the San Andres.

We amend the cement program as follows:

- 1) Lead Cement - Class 'C' + 2.00% SMS + 1.00% R-3 + 0.25 lb/sk Cello Flake + 0.005 lb/sk Static Free
Changed to meet compressive strength requirements
500 psi CS in 21 hrs @ 80 degrees F
- 2) Tail Cement - Class 'C' + 0.25 lb/sk Cello Flake + 0.005 lb/sk Static Free
Omitted 1% CaCl2 in order to have sufficient pump time
Pump time with no CaCl2 = 2 hrs 40 minutes.
Pump time with 1% CaCl2 = 1 hr 30 minutes

Number of sacks and yield should always be provided with cement charges
