The soil on this location was worked to re-establish natural conditions and topography. This is an abandoned oilfield location known as the "Jo Federal #1". Details for this reclamation process include:

- · A D6 Caterpillar Dozer was used to move soil to match the surrounding area. This meant displacing the existing flat location pad and re-contouring the surface to have sand dunes and small hills.
- · Wind rows were put in place to control major rain run off which would cause washing out of new seed, plants and soil.
- Two large rolls of straw were mixed in with top soil to aid against wind erosion of soil and seed mix. It is also a natural fertilizer.
- The road leading to the old location was ripped and capped with native soil immediately along side of road.
- The entire area was seeded with BLM mix "LPC".
- · Photos were taken before dozer work began and after. Please see attached photos.
- · Upon completion surface soil was field tested for Chlorides and Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons. No elevated levels were identified for surface
