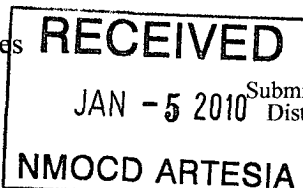

Confirmation results will be submitted. Area will be remediated to NMOCD guidelines.
