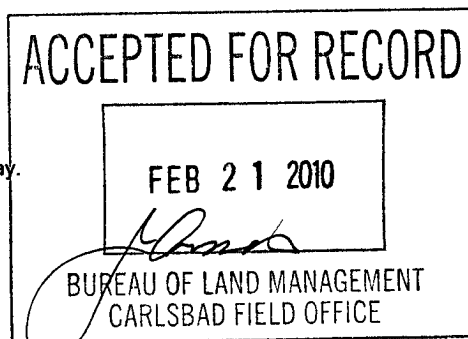

1-20-10: TIH w/ pkr and 312 jts 2-3/8", EOT @ 10,340'. RU Howco and spot 1000 gal 10% MCA. Break down Atoka perfs 10,340 - 44', broke @ 4516 psi, est rate 2.5 BPM @ 5000 psi.

1-21-10: Open to tank and blow down on various chokes. RU swab, IFL 4100' and broken, made 5 runs recovering 15 BTF. FFL 9300'. Color cut indicates 7BO 11 BLW recovered for the day.

1-22-10: Swab testing well.
