Clean out & Acidize Current Perforations

Procedure:

Rigged up on well 6/18/2010 to pull pump. Found multiple 3/4" rod boxes bad. Scale on most of 3/4" rods and in pump. Release tubing and tagged TD @ 3838' (121' below bottom perf).

- 1) Pick up Treating Packer on tubing.
- 2) Hydro Test tubing in hole.
- 3) Rig up Acid Company with 3000 gallons 15% NEFE Anti-Sludge Hydrochloric Acid containing H_2S scavenger for 5000 ppm H_2S + 1% MiCellar Solvent by volume.
- 4) Run in hole to land packer @ 1st full joint above 3500'
- 5) Spot acid to end of tubing and set packer.
- 6) Acidize perfs 3541-3717 with 3000 gallons and flush to bottom perf.
- 7) Flow back until well dies.
- 8) Release packer and retrieve bridge plug.
- 9) Pull up and set RBP @ 3700'
- 10) Set packer @ +/- 3300
- 11) Acidize perfs 3383-3597 with 3000 gallons and flush to bottom perf.
- 12) Flow back until well dies.
- 13) Swab back remaining load
- 14) Release packer.
- 15) Pull tubing and loaydonw packer
- 16) Pick up and run pumping bottom hole assembly.
- 17) Run rods and pump.
- 18) Test well until stabilized and perform scale squeeze.
