Dear Roy:

We are returning form C-103, Report on Partially Plugging, Atha Exploration Co., Lightcap No. 1, SW/4 NW/4 section 24, T.7 S, R.28 E, Chaves County wildcat. This has not been approved in the Hobbs office.

Also, we would like to call your attention to all wells on State lands that are converted into water wells and accepted by the grazing lessee. Form C-103 should be approved by the Oil and Gas Inspector, accepted by the grazing lessee, then forwarded to Land Commissioner Miles for his approval. Then the completed form in the Oil Commission may be used as authority to cancel any bonds.
