Gentlemen:

Commission Form C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill, the above mentioned well was approved on May 26, 1966, and no further reports have been filed.

According to the latest information available to us the well was at TD 6495, preparing to run a drill stem test. Commission Rule 1103 reads in part as follows. Within ten days following the commencement of drilling operations, the operator of the well shall file a report thereof on Form C-103 in triplicate. Such report shall indicate the hour and the date the well was spudded. Also a report of casing and cement test shall be filed within ten days following the setting of each string of casing or liner. Said report must show the grade and weight of the casing, type and amount of cement used.

Please file these forms as soon as possible.
