STATEMENT PERTAINING TO 12 POINT
DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR SURFACE USE
AND DRILLING OPERATIONS

Gentlemen:

In connection with the application for permit to drill the above captioned test, our development plan for surface use is as follows:

- (1.) The existing road to be used is a Caliche road which originates at U. S. Highway 380, approximately 29 miles west of Caprock, New Mexico, and terminates at a point 1000 feet from the north line and 1980 feet from the east line of Section 26, Township 11 South, Range 27 East. This road serves the Coyote-Queen Oil Field, the Chisum Oil Field, and was used for access to the two recent Secan wells in Section 26, Township 11 South, Range 27 East, Chaves County, New Mexico.
- (2.) The planned access road to the location will be a continuance of the existing road and it will generally follow an easterly direction from a point 1000 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 26, Township 11 South, Range 27 East to the location. In other words, the access road will generally parallel the North line of Section 26 and Section 25, Township 11 South, Range 27 East, as shown on the attached map.
