9. & 10 Proposed Pool(s): Put in the pool name(s) that you are , or intend to be, producing from. Pool 1 is for the deepest zone. On new well this information is usually obtained from the geologist or from the file of an offset well completed in the same pool. CAUTION many pools include both the area and formation as part of their name (example Monument Tubb).

11. Work Type Code: Use one of the following Codes:

- E Re-entry N New well
- D Drill deeper P Plugback
- A Add a zone

12. Well Type Code: Use one of the following Codes; G Single gas completion

- O Single oil completion
- M Multiple completion
- S SWD well
- I Injection well W Water supply well
- C Carbon dioxide well

13. Cable/Rotary: Indicate what type of rig is to be used.

14. Lease Type Code: Use one of the following Codes:

P Private S State

Information obtained from land department or by looking at leasing agreement.

15. Ground level Elevation: From Form C102 supplied by surveyor

16. Multiple: Indicate multiple completion Y/N

17. Proposed Depth: Proposed total depth. Usually from geologist or drilling dept.

18. Formation: Formation name at TD, usually from geologist .

19. Contractor: Rig contractor, if unknown at time of application indicate UNKNOWN

20. Spud Date: Anticipated Spud date. Usually from Drilling department
