On April 3, 1975 140 net barrels of oil were transferred from our State "CF" Well No. 5 - Incomplete to our Cato Storage System No. 3. The oil was to have been used as drilling mud additives. It was transferred to the Cato Storage System III which has adequate treating facilities and pipeline connections for running the oil. Originally this is Cato San Andres pool oil coming from the Fischer "B" Federal Lease.
