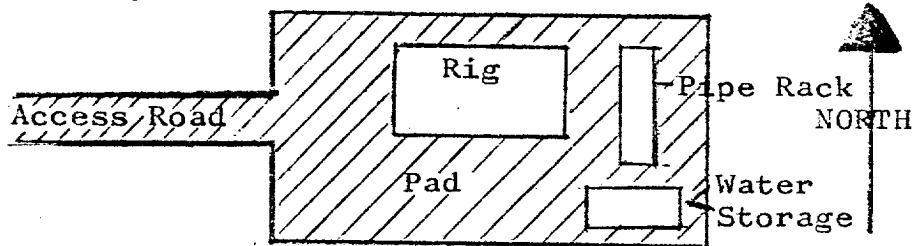


10. This wildcat will be drilled with cable tools and therefore there will not be any mud tanks, reserve pits or burn pits. The layout of the rig and pad is shown below.



11. The surface will be levelled and if the Bureau of Land Management so requests, I will reseed the small amount of grass that has been destroyed in the area.
12. The topography at the proposed drill site is of very low relief. The soil is extremely sandy with sparse vegetation consisting of a few clumps of grass, mesquite, scrub oak and a few cacti.
