On May 9, 1975, this well was plugged back from 10,256' TD in the Devonian to base of the 8-5/8" casing at 2450'. On May 19 the Queen sand was perforated with 2 jet shots per ft. from 1754' - 1756' and 1760' - 1764'. The perforations were acidized with 1500 gal. of acid and swabbed dry. Pursuant to telephone conversation with Mr. Gressett this well was plugged and abandoned May 20, 1975, with a 35 sack plug from 1800 - 1700' across the Queen perforations and a 10 sack plug and marker at surface. The plug was spotted with heavy drilling mud and the work was done by Halliburton.
