Contacted Sheriff Leroy Carpenter, Roswell, New Mexico and he advised El Paso Well No. 1 was located on his son's ranch located approximately 16 to 17 miles east of Roswell, New Mexico.

Attempted to contact David Carpenter November 28, 1977 at the sale barn where he works part-time but was advised he was not working that particular day. Did contact David Carpenter November 29, 1977 and he advised the last he knew about this well was that they were at 300 feet and had just hauled out the surface pipe to set but they never did set the surface pipe. Later someone came by and hauled off this particular pipe. Stated they did haul a bunch of rocks in and dumped it in the hole and all it was was one big mess over there. It was David's opinion they were definitely not over 400 feet and had planned to set this surface feet at 300 feet which they did not do.

It appears this well will have to be drilled out and plugged properly to satisfy the state authorities.
