We are pleased to submit a Mud Program for your "Midwest Federal #3." to be drilled in Section 22, Chaves County, New Mexico.

- 0 400' TMC Gel and Lime, Vis. 36-38, for hole conditions.
- 400 2850' Drill with native mud, Vis. 30-31. Add Mud Seal if needed for seepage. Add Lime or Caustic for P.H. control 9.5 - 10.
- 2850 6000' Drill with fresh water circulating reserve pit for solids control. Add Lime or Caustic for P.H. control 9.5 - 10. Add Mud Seal if needed for seepage.
- 6000 8000<sup>\*</sup> Add Salt Gel to raise Vis. 32-33. Add 2-3% Oil. Maintain P.H. 9.5-10. with Caustic. For D.S.T. lower W/L 20cc.
- 8000 8800' Maintain Vis. 33-34, Lower W/L 20cc or less, 2-3% Oil.
- 8800' T.D. Lower W/L 5cc or less, Raise Vis. 36-38 if needed for D.S.T. and logging.
