AND OPERATIONS PLAN

Well Name: Blakemore Federal #1

Location: 660/N 660/W Sec 20 Twn9S Rge26E Chaves County

1. Existing Roads: Ranch road running apprx. 700' from location,
west in Sec. 19, goes North to Portales highway apprx.
5 miles.
2. Planned Access Roads: Repair to established road running north
from location, install cattle guards in fence line between
Sec. 6 and Sec. 7, where small gates are now located, and
1/2 mile to fence in Sec. 7 for second guard.
3. Location of Existing Wells: Wells in Sec. 3, 10, 6, 14, 16,
& 31 of Twn9S Rge26E.
4. Location of Tank Batteries, Production Facilities, and Production,
Gathering, and Service Lines: If well is a producer, tanks
and production equipment will be on the southwest corner
of pad. All lines will stay on pad.
5. Location and Type of Water Supply (rivers, creeks, lakes, ponds, wells):
CLM Transportation will haul by truck from Roswell,
approximately 12 miles.
6. Source of Construction Materials: Caliche 6" thick, watered and compacted, 12' wide
on road repair, new road and location will not be padded
with caliche, only graded, watered and packed.
7. Methods of Handling Waste Disposal: Pit dug 5' deep on northeast corner of location. Reserve
pit and working pits for drilling fluid and cuttings.
8. Ancillary Facilities: none
