

MULTIPOINT DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR SURFACE USE

1. Existing roads are shown on the attached maps.

- A. Staking plat attached to form 9-331 C.
- B. The nearest town is Kenna, New Mexico which is 11-1/2 miles west of location as shown on attached map as Exhibit No. 4. Take Highway 70 to Kenna, turn west on county road (southside of picnic area), follow main road 11-1/2 miles. Turn right (north) down east side of fence, follow road 1/2 mile, turn left .1 mile to location.
- C. Shown on map as Exhibit No. 4.

- E. Shown on map, all natural roads.
- F. Existing road will be widened and repaired as necessary. Road will be graded as needed for maintenance.

2. Planned Access Road.

As shown on attached map, we propose to construct approximately 530' of access road from existing road to location by grading along natural contour of land.

- A. Maximum width of 16'.
- B. No major grades.
- C. No turnouts.
- D. Drainage will be natural.
- E. No culverts are proposed to be installed and there are no major cuts or fills anticipated.
- F. Surfacing material will be native soil with no material hauled.
- G. There will be no gates, cattleguards, or fence cuts.
- H. Road has been flagged with red flagging material.
