WOC 18 hrs then bail the hole dry. If no water enters the casing in 1 hr., continue to drill hole with a 10" bit to 2675 and run 8 5/8" 24 lb. casing with 100 sx Dowell Class "C" cement with 2% CaCl. A guide shoe and insert float will be run on the first joint.
