If you have run this pipe, please submit three (3) copies of form C-103 on each string of casing.

Also, we have received no communication regarding your State Well No. 3, Unit G, Sec. 28-11S-27E, since October 12, 1959. Rule 202 of Commission Rules and Regulations states that a well should be plugged and abandoned when drilling operations have been suspended for 60 days, unless a permit for temporary abandonment has been obtained from the Commission.

Please inform this office as to the status of the above wells at once else appropriate action will be taken.
